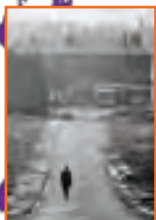

A predominant theme is that of music. The characters' rejection of pop songs reinforces the sense that the performers play for some other aim than the pure celebration of music.

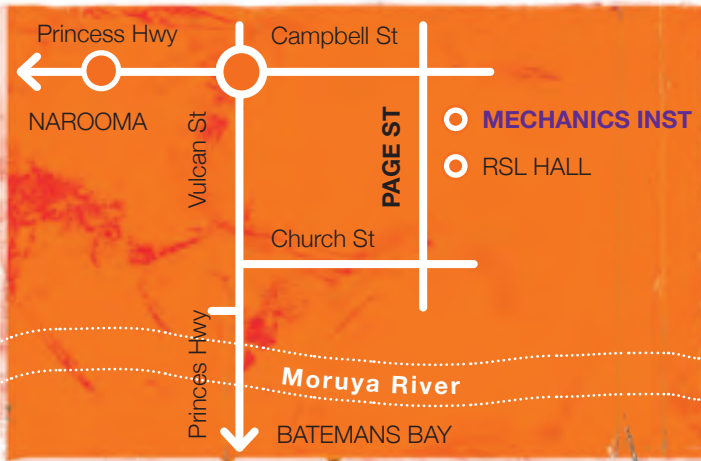

## MORUYA JAZZ FESTIVAL

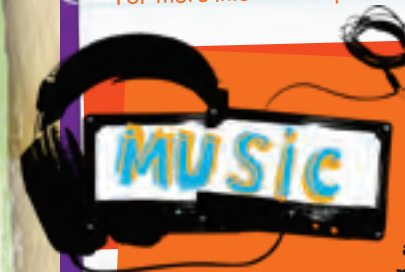
23 24 25 OCTOBER
